An Overview on Foundational Courses and Core Requirements:

Most required courses are designated with a **100 level** or **300 level** course number:

- » 100 level: course fulfills a core requirement and has no prerequisites; or
- » 300 level: course fulfills a core requirement and has prerequisites.

Foundational courses must be fulfilled by taking courses in Hebrew Bible, New Testament, and Church History within the first 30 credit hours. Beyond the foundational courses, there are certain core requirements that must be fulfilled by particular courses *only*. Other core requirements may be fulfilled by taking one of several courses.

A breakdown of these core requirements for the **M.Div. degree** is as follows:

- » Christian Teaching and Formation - *Any 100-level CF course*
- » Leadership in Ministry - *Any combination of 100- or 300-level CM courses (3 credits total required)*
- » Christian Ethics - *Any 300-level ES course*
- » Pastoral Care and Counseling - *Any 100-level PC course*
- » Preaching Practicum - *Any 300-level PW course higher than 325*
- » Religion and the Arts - *Any combination of 100-level RA courses (2 credits total required)*
- » Ministry and Social Sciences - *As listed below*
- » The Church in an Interreligious World - *As listed below*
