Accessing the Wesley Textbook Website

The site is hosted by Amazon, and so you may purchase your books directly through the site just as if you were shopping on Amazon.com. More information about setting up an Amazon Student account is below.

Please note that the textbooks listed on our site are all new, print editions. Therefore, you may still choose to seek out used copies or e-reader editions.

There are two ways to access our textbook website:

- 1. Go directly to http://astore.amazon.com/wesletheolsem-20
- 2. Go to MyWesley
 - a. Click the "Textbooks" icon on the left.

Once on the website, you will see a landing page that has some useful information for you. You may then find and purchase your books through the following steps:

- 1. Click on the correct semester.
- 2. Click on the course ID.
- 3. Click on the book you wish to purchase.
- 4. Click "Add to Shopping Cart."
- 5. Click "Continue Shopping."
- 6. Repeat steps 1-5 as necessary to add the books you need.
- 7. Ensure that the books listed are correct!*
- 8. Click "Proceed to Checkout."**
- 9. Click "Continue."

At this point, your books will be added to a shopping cart through Amazon.com and you can proceed through checkout as you would with any other Amazon purchase.

*If you do not make corrections to your shopping cart on our textbook website before continuing to step 8, and you click "No, take me back to Amazon.com" on the following confirmation screen, you will lose the books you have placed in your cart.

**If you notice errors after step 8, it is easier to proceed to step 9 and then remove the unwanted books from your shopping cart once it has been transferred to Amazon.com. You can also go back to the textbook website and add additional books to the shopping cart before checking out if you have missed something.

Creating an Amazon Student Account

As a student, you may sign up for an Amazon Student account using your "@students.wesleyseminary.edu" email address.

The Amazon Student account will give you Amazon Prime benefits free for six months. After the initial six months, you can choose to continue to the service at a discounted rate of \$39 per year, or you can discontinue the service with no charge. *If you do not cancel your membership it will automatically charge you the \$39. You are not required to set up any account with Amazon, but we want to make you aware of the benefits of Amazon Student.*

Amazon Prime benefits include free two day shipping or standard shipping on eligible purchases, free access to Amazon Instant Video, and access to the Kindle Owner's Lending Library.
