## Adding YouTube Videos

YouTube videos can be put in Blackboard in a way that will place a player directly into the content area. This is the recommended way to add YouTube videos because it removes all recommendations, URL info and comments.


 Navigate to Blackboard then enter your username and password. You can do this either through mywesley or blackboard.wesleyseminary.ed u




2. Enter your course.




3. Make sure Edit Mode is On.



4. In the Course Menu, click on the content area to which you would like to add the YouTube Video.




5. Click YouTube Video.



6. Search for the video you wish to use. Unfortunately, you cannot copy in the URL directly, but must search for the video.




7. The search results will display below the search box. Scroll through to locate the desired video (if it is not first on the list). Click Select.



8. You can change the name of the video and add a description or instructions.


