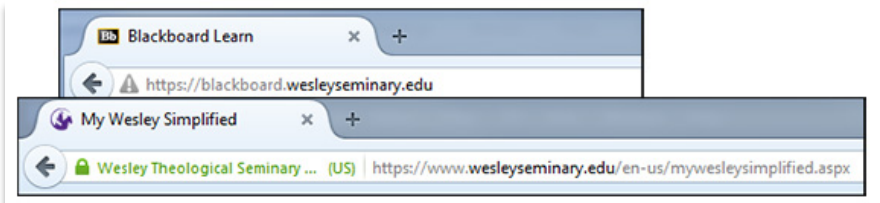


Adding YouTube Videos

YouTube videos can be put in Blackboard in a way that will place a player directly into the content area. This is the recommended way to add YouTube videos because it removes all recommendations, URL info and comments.

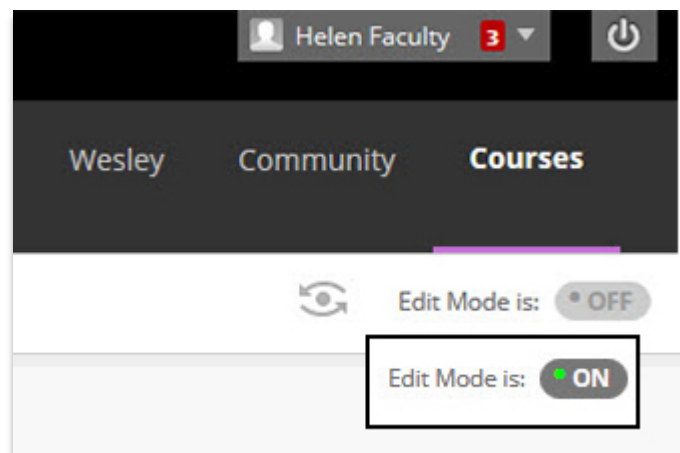
1. Navigate to Blackboard then enter your username and password. You can do this either through mywesley or blackboard.wesleyseminary.edu



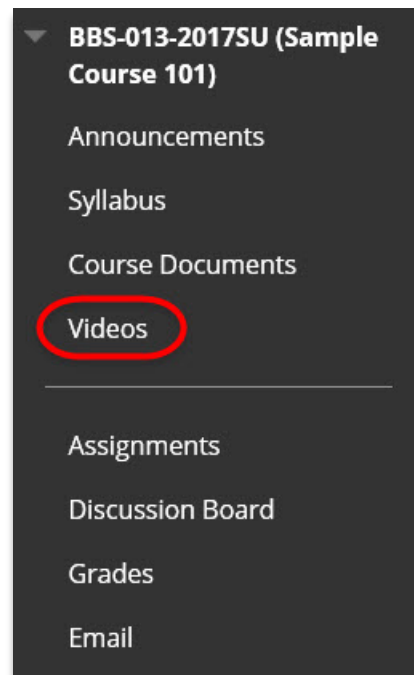
2. Enter your course.



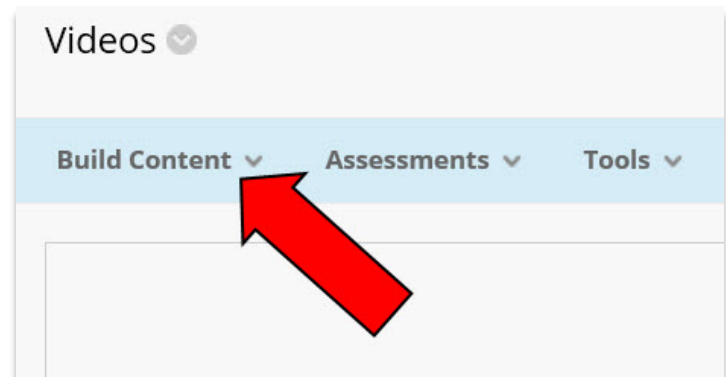
3. Make sure Edit Mode is On.





4. In the Course Menu, click on the content area to which you would like to add the YouTube video. In this example it is labeled Videos.

5. Mouse over **Build Content**.




6. Click **YouTube Video**.




