## Worship information

Graduating seniors are our preachers for our time of worship. Faculty who are elders will preside at the table. Each year we work to schedule different types of worship experiences including hymn sings, a love feast and non traditional worship practices.

- In addition to the mid-day worship experience students are invited to a morning devotion before classes. This is an informal time of gathering and sharing concerns with one another and is student lead.
- Each class will elect a president, secretary and treasurer. The President will serve as the worship coordinator who is responsible for the coordination of devotions and prayer concerns in the classroom. They will also coordinate class participants for the mid day worship working with Barbara Papendorp
