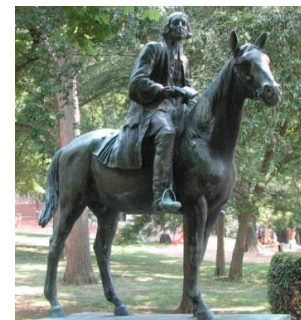


“A New Methodism for a New Day”: Forward by Grace (2021)
