Program Notes: In addition, students must take two elective courses for a total of 30 credit hours.

Project Seminar: May be taken after completing 24 credits. The Project Seminar is offered several times a year both in person and on-line. A project proposal must be approved by DMin Committee nine months before anticipated graduation.

Two Electives: Taken in variety of formats including classroom, online, and study trips arranged by Wesley Theological Seminary.

Electives may include:

- Courses taken in another track, on campus or on-line
- Travel trips to the Civil Rights in Birmingham, AL
- Leadership Institute lead by Church of the Resurrection in Leawood, KS
