



Submitting a Video Discussion


1. Log in to Blackboard at <https://sso.wesleyseminary.edu> or blackboard.wesleyseminary.edu




2. Enter your course by clicking the course title box.




3. Click **Discussions** in the Menu along the upper left. Or access the Discussion through the Weekly Module.




4. Click the title of the Discussion Forum for which you are submitting.




5. Click **inside** the box labeled **Type Response**




6. Click the plus sign in the circle to open a menu.




7. Click **Content Market** in the new menu.




8. Click **Kaltura Media**



9. Locate the video you wish to submit in your MyMedia Library, and click **Embed**



10. Check the video Display title, and retype if necessary. Click **Insert**






11. Your video will now show in the text editor.
