- Coordinates and oversees all aspects of the church's Safe Sanctuary Policy
- Develops nursery workers and volunteers schedules and delegates volunteer responsibilities

Community Outreach Responsibilities

- Develop and execute outreach programs to schools and other organizations outside of the church
- Create and maintain relationships with other local churches and Christian groups to facilitate children, youth, and young adult family programs
- Lead the outreach to unchurched youth, children, and young adults in our community
